AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11012 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO RENAME THE DEDEDO ELEMENTARY
SCHOOL THE "MARIA A. ULLOA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL."

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11012 is hereby added to the Government Code of
3 Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 11012. Maria A. Ulloa Elementary School. The elementary
5 school heretofore known as the Dededo Elementary School is hereby re-
6 named the 'Maria A. Ulloa Elementary School' to honor the late school
7 teacher from Dededo who served so capably in the public school system
8 of Guam for a period of over half a century. At such ceremony
9 as the Director deems appropriate, said school shall be so officially
10 named at which time a plaque bearing the name, picture, and a brief
11 history of Maria A. Ulloa shall be affixed at a suitable spot within
12 the school."

13 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
