AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6118(a) OF
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM REGARDING
ILLEGAL EXPENDITURES OF GOVERNMENT
FUNDS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 6118(a) of the Government Code of Guam
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6118. Illegal Expenditures. (a) No
5 officer or employee of the government of Guam, including
6 the Governor of Guam, shall:

- 7 (1) Make or authorize any expenditure from, or create
8 or authorize an obligation under, any appropriation
9 or fund in excess of the amount available therein,
10 or for other than an authorized purpose;
- 11 (2) Commence, continue, or proceed with any operational
12 activity, construction, improvement, contract, or
13 obligation without an appropriation or fund for the
14 payment thereof, or after any such appropriation or
15 fund is exhausted;
- 16 (3) Involve the government of Guam in any contract or
17 other obligation, for the payment of money for any
18 purpose, in advance of an appropriation made for
19 such purpose;
- 20 (4) Employ personnel or accept voluntary service except
21 as authorized by law."
