AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6118(2) OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM REGARDING ILLEGAL EXPENDITURES OF GOVERNMENT FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 6118(a) of the Government Code of Guam
is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6118. Illegal Expenditures. (a) No officer or employee of the government of Guam; including the Governor of Guam, shall:

- (1) Make or authorize any expenditure from, or create or authorize an obligation under, any appropriation or fund in excess of the amount available therein, or for other than an authorized purpose;
- (2) Commence, continue, or proceed with any operational activity, construction, improvement, contract, or obligation without an appropriation or fund for the payment thereof, or after any such appropriation or fund is exhausted;
- (3) Involve the government of Guam in any contract or other obligation, for the payment of money for any purpose, in advance of an appropriation made for such purpose;
- (4) Employ personnel or accept voluntary service except as authorized by law."
