Committee on Rules, by request of the Governor in accordance with Section 6 (b) of the Organic Act of Guam.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE LOANS TO THE COMMERCIAL PORT OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. There are hereby authorized to be advanced from the General Fund, with the approval of the Committee on Rules of the Legislature, such temporary loans to the Commercial Port, without interest, as may be necessary to finance the operations of the Commercial Port, or to finance capital replacement in the event of emergency or disaster or to provide working capital for the Commercial Port pending subsidy appropriations by the Legislature.

Section 2. The authority granted by this Act shall expire June 30, 1969.
