


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19592 OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO AUTHORIZE  
A TAX DRAWBACK FOR SALES TO SHIPS  
STORES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 19592, of the Government Code of Guam is  
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 19592. Export Drawback. There shall be allowed  
5 to any applicant therefor an export drawback of the full amount  
6 of a tax paid under this subchapter, exclusive of penalties and  
7 interest, upon fulfillment of the following conditions:

8 .01. That the tobacco manufactured or produced in Guam or  
9 brought into Guam, has been consigned, and duly delivered to a  
10 point outside the territory of Guam, or delivered on board a  
11 ship or vessel for ship store use or ship's consumption;

12 .02. That the tobacco so exported or so delivered for ship  
13 store use or ship's consumption, was not subject to any sale  
14 within Guam other than a transfer involving substantially all the  
15 stock in trade, good will and franchise or other rights concern-  
16 ing the tobacco upon which the tax was paid;

17 .03. That the taxes levied hereunder have been fully paid  
18 to the government of Guam; and

19 .04. That the applicant is a duly licensed manufacturer,  
20 producer, wholesaler or retailer in Guam."

21 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
