AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 1102.2 TO  
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO  
REQUIRE THAT NO BILL SHALL BE  
PASSED BY THE LEGISLATURE WITH  
LESS THAN ELEVEN AFFIRMATIVE VOTES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 1102.2 is hereby added to the Government  
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 1102.2. Number of Votes Required. No bill  
5 shall be passed by the Legislature with less than eleven  
6 affirmative votes."

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
