AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11843 TO THE GOVERN-
MENT CODE OF GUAM TO RENAME THE COLLEGE OF
GUAM LIBRARY AFTER THE LATE ROBERT F. KENNEDY,
SENATOR FROM NEW YORK AND GREAT AMERICAN
PATRIOT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11843 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 11843. Robert F. Kennedy Memorial Library: Statement of
5 Findings. The Legislature finding that the late Robert F. Kennedy, United
6 States Senator from New York, former Attorney General of the United States,
7 and lifelong advocate of democracy, best exemplifies the ideals and
8 principles of dedication to duty, love of his community, and respect for the
9 laws of the nation and of God sought to be inculcated in the students attend-
10 ing the College of Guam, his affinity for college students and his empathetic
11 understanding of their idealistic drives and desires making him, justifiably,
12 the nonpareil leader of the younger generation, and his devotion to the cause
13 of advancing the rights of the minority members of American society and
14 extending the benefits and responsibilities of the Constitutional concept

1 of citizenship to every American wherever residing and of whatever race or
2 creed making him a particularly compelling and attractive figure to the
3 students of Guam, that part of the United States most remote from the main-
4 land and whose residents are the most recently created American citizens,
5 the college library located at the campus of the College of Guam, Mangilao,
6 is hereby designated the 'Robert F. Kennedy Memorial Library' and, at such
7 ceremony as the Governor of Guam deems appropriate said library shall be
8 so officially named and dedicated. At such ceremony, a suitable bust or
9 picture of Senator Kennedy shall be placed in said building and a plaque
10 describing his career and his contributions to the country he loved shall
11 be affixed thereat, the people of Guam being determined to preserve his
12 memory and cherish his faith in America, believing full well that had he
13 not been tragically struck down in the midst of a magnificent public career,
14 he would have claimed an even more important role in the future of his country
15 and of this territory."

16 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
