AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11843 TO THE GOVERN-MENT CODE OF GUAM TO RENAME THE COLLEGE OF GUAM LIBRARY AFTER THE LATE ROBERT F. KENNEDY, SENATOR FROM NEW YORK AND GREAT AMERICAN PATRIOT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 11843 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 11843. Robert F. Kennedy Memorial Library: Statement of Findings. The Legislature finding that the late Robert F. Kennedy, United States Senator from New York, former Attorney General of the United States, and lifelong advocate of democracy, best exemplifies the ideals and principles of dedication to duty, love of his community, and respect for the laws of the nation and of God sought to be inculcated in the students attending the Gollege of Guam, his affinity for college students and his empathetic understanding of their idealistic drives and desires making him, justifiably, the nonpareil leader of the younger generation, and his devotion to the cause of advancing the rights of the minority members of American society and extending the benefits and responsibilities of the Constitutional concept

of citizenship to every American wherever residing and of whatever race or creed making him a particularly compelling and attractive figure to the students of Guam, that part of the United States most remote from the main—land and whose residents are the most recently created American citizens, the college library located at the campus of the College of Guam, Mangilao, is hereby designated the 'Robert F. Kennedy Memorial Library' and, at such ceremony as the Governor of Guam deems appropriate said library shall be so officially named and dedicated. At such ceremony, a suitable bust or picture of Senator Kennedy shall be placed in said building and a plaque describing his career and his contributions to the country he loved shall be affixed thereat, the people of Guam being determined to preserve his memory and cherish his faith in America, believing full well that had he not been tragically struck down in the midst of a magnificient public career, he would have claimed an even more important role in the future of his country and of this territory."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
