AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49010 OF THE GOVERN-MENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FREE HOSPITALIZA-TION AND MEDICAL CARE FOR PERSONS AFFLICTED WITH LYTICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 49010 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 49010. Tuberculosis and lytico patients. Persons afflicted with tuberculosis or lytico (Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis or Parkinsonism—Dementia) shall receive hospitalization and medical care without charge.

No fees shall be charged for immunizations or for services rendered by village dispensaries or prenatal clinics."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
