AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 123 TO THE GOVERN-
MENT CODE OF GUAM TO ADOPT THE LOCAL FLOWER
KNOWN AS "PUTI TAI NOBIO" AS THE OFFICIAL
FLOWER OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 123 is hereby added to the Government Code
3 of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 123. Guam Flower. There shall be and is hereby
5 adopted an official territorial flower of Guam, which shall be
6 the local flower known as 'Puti Tai Nobio'."

7 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
