AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION a(4) OF SECTION
252, CHAPTER I, TITLE V, CODE OF CIVIL
PROCEDURE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE JURIS-
DICTION OF THE JUVENILE COURT OF GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Subsection a(4) of Section 252, Chapter I, Title V, Code of
3 Civil Procedure of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 252 a(4). Who is alleged to have violated or attempted
5 to violate any federal, state or territorial law regardless of where the
6 violation occurred. Provided, that the Juvenile Court shall not have
7 jurisdiction with respect to any child 16 years of age or older who is
8 alleged to have committed any offense under the Vehicle Code (Title XXIV
9 of the Government Code of Guam) if such offense is within the jurisdiction
10 of the Police Court."

11 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
