AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION a(4) OF SECTION 252, CHAPTER I, TITLE V, CODE OF CIVIL PROCEDURE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE JURIS-DICTION OF THE JUVENILE COURT OF GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PECALE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection a(4) of Section 252, Chapter 1, Title V, Code of Civil Procedure of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 252 a(4). Who is alleged to have violated or attempted to violate any federal, state or territorial law regardless of where the violation occurred. Provided, that the Juvenile Court shall not have jurisdiction with respect to any child 16 years of age or older who is alleged to have committed any offense under the Vehicle Code (Title XXIV of the Government Code of Guam) if such offense is within the jurisdiction of the Police Court."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
