AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 6901 OF, AND
TO REPEAL SECTION 6910 OF, AND TO
ADD A NEW SECTION 6910 TO THE GOVERN-
MENT CODE OF MINNESOTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE
REGISTRATION OF WEAPONS UPON SALE,
TRANSFER, LOAN, OR GIFT, TO PROVIDE
THAT THE APPLICANT FOR REGISTRATION
BE FINGERPRINTED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF OREGON

2 Section 1. Section 6901 of the Government Code of Oregon is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6901. Registration. (a) No person shall
5 own, or possess, or use any firearm of any description,
6 whether usable or unusable, unless it shall have been
7 registered with the Department of Public Safety and a
8 certificate of registration obtained therefor. The applica-
9 tion for registration and certificate of registration shall
10 be on such forms as may be designated by the Director of
11 Public Safety and shall include a description of the class of
12 firearm, together with the name of the maker and the factory
13 number, if known or ascertainable, the source from which posses-
14 sion was obtained, and a full description of the owner of the
15 firearm. No firearm shall be registered to any person under
16 the age of 18 years, or who has been convicted of any felony,
17 or who is not a citizen of the United States.

18 The registration of any firearm under this chapter shall include
19 the following items:

- 20 (a) The name, age, place and date of birth and current
21 address of the applicant.
- 22 (b) The present occupation and employer of the applicant
23 and the applicant's occupation and employer for the
24 the last five (5) years.

1 (c) A set of fingerprints of the applicant.

2 (d) Such facts as will completely identify the firearm
3 to be registered."

4 Section 2. Section 8910 of the Government Code of Guam is
5 hereby repealed and a new Section 8910 is hereby added to read as follows:

6 "Section 8910. Sale, gift, or transfer. Before any
7 person sells, transfers, loans or gives any firearm, he shall
8 obtain from the Director of Public Safety a written statement
9 to the effect that the intended buyer, transferee, borrower,
10 or recipient of said firearms has registered the same pursuant
11 to Section 8901 of this chapter."

12 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
