AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 2313 AND 2315
OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RAISING
THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF ELECTION EXPENSES
FROM \$100 PER NOMINEE TO \$1,000.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 2313 of the Government Code of Guam is here-
3 by amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 2313. Same: incidental expenses. As a part of
5 lawful expenses, independent nominees, committees, and political
6 parties may expend money for necessary incidental expenses,
7 which, plus traveling expenses do not exceed one thousand dollars
8 (\$1,000) per nominee."

9 Section 2. Section 2315 of the Government Code of Guam is here-
10 by amended to read as follows:

11 "Section 2315. Maximum amount of expense. No sum may be
12 paid and no expense may be incurred, directly or indirectly, by
13 or on behalf of a nominee, whether before, during or after an
14 election at which he is a candidate, in excess of one thousand
15 dollars (\$1,000.00)."

16 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
