Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Thirty Four Thousand Dollars (\$34,000) to supplement the appropriation made by Section 1 of Public Law 9-167, Ninth Guam Legislature, to provide Student Summer Employment.

Section 3. The Governor's Committee on Children and Youth is hereby authorized to pay out of the appropriation made by Section 2 of this Act the wages of the supervisors needed to carry out the Committee's program.

Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to the Legislature to provide for the editing, codifying, printing and binding of the laws of Guar and the rules of court, and any supplements thereto. Such fund shall be expended under the direction of the Committee on Bules of the Legislature. The sale and distribution of all codes and supplements thereto shall be made under such conditions and at such prices as may from time to time be fixed by legis lative resolution.

Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds
in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thouand Dollars (215,000) to provide for private council to essist in the
enforcement of the excise tax on alcoholic beverages consumed in Guam.

Section 6. Subitem D of Item I of Section 3 of Public Law 9-167,

Ninth Guam Legislature is hereby amended to read as follows:

"D Renovation of Agana Public Utility Building to

provide an Executive Office Building \$30,000"

Section 7. Appropriations made by this Act shall be effective immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for which made or until the project is completed.

Section 8. This Act is an urgency measure.
