AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR
NECESSARY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PRO-
JECTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated from any
3 available fund in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the
4 following purposes:

5 I For General Government:

1 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available
2 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Thirty
3 Four Thousand Dollars (\$34,000) to supplement the appropriation made by
4 Section 1 of Public Law 9-167, Ninth Guam Legislature, to provide Student
5 Summer Employment.

6 Section 3. The Governor's Committee on Children and Youth is
7 hereby authorized to pay out of the appropriation made by Section 2 of this
8 Act the wages of the supervisors needed to carry out the Committee's pro-
9 gram.

10 ~~Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds~~
11 ~~in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred~~
12 ~~Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to the Legislature to provide for the edit-~~
13 ~~ing, codifying, printing and binding of the laws of Guam and the rules of~~
14 ~~court, and any supplements thereto. Such fund shall be expended under the~~
15 ~~direction of the Committee on Rules of the Legislature. The sale and dis-~~
16 ~~tribution of all codes and supplements thereto shall be made under such~~
17 ~~conditions and at such prices as may from time to time be fixed by legis-~~
18 ~~lative resolution.~~

19 ~~Section 5. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds~~
20 ~~in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifteen Thou-~~
21 ~~sand Dollars (\$15,000) to provide for private counsel to assist in the~~
22 ~~enforcement of the excise tax on alcoholic beverages consumed in Guam.~~

23 Section 6. Subitem D of Item I of Section 3 of Public Law 9-167,
24 Ninth Guam Legislature is hereby amended to read as follows:

25 "D Renovation of Agana Public Utility Building to
26 provide an Executive Office Building \$30,000"

27 Section 7. Appropriations made by this Act shall be effective
28 immediately, and shall be available for all expenses incident to the purposes
29 for which made. Every appropriation made herein shall continue in full
30 force and effect and shall be available until expended for the project for
31 which made or until the project is completed.

32 Section 8. This Act is an urgency measure.
