AN ACT TO RENUMBER SECTION 4020 OF THE GOVERN-
MENT CODE OF GUAM TO SECTION 4025 AND TO ADD
A NEW SECTION 4020 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF
GUAM TO AUTHORIZE GROUP LIFE INSURANCE FOR THE
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYEES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4020 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
3 renumbered Section 4025.

4 Section 2. A new Section 4020 is hereby added to the Government Code
5 of Guam to read as follows:

6 "Section 4020. Group Life Insurance. (a) The Governor is authorized
7 to enter into contracts with one or more insurance companies authorized to
8 do business in Guam for group life insurance for all employees or separate
9 groups of employees of the government of Guam.

10 (b) All participation by employees in such contracts of life
11 insurance shall be on a voluntary basis and one half of all premiums for
12 any such policy shall be paid by employees participating and the remaining
13 half shall be paid for by the government of Guam. The government of Guam
14 shall also provide payroll deductions for the payment of premiums.

15 (c) Contracts of insurance procured under the foregoing shall
16 be limited to a face amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) except that
17 double indemnity may be allowed to those who elect to pay the additional
18 premium.

19 (d) 'Employees' as used in this section includes officers and retired
20 employees."

21 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
