


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

Introduced by J. C. Arriola

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11001.6 TO
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO RE-
QUIRE THAT ALL CONTRACTS FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS COST-
ING IN EXCESS OF \$2,500 BE PUBLICLY
SOLICITED.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11001.6 is hereby added to the Govern-
3 ment Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 11001.6. Public Bids Required. No contract
5 for the construction of public works in which the estimated
6 cost is in excess of \$2,500 shall be executed by the govern-
7 ment of Guam unless the same shall have been awarded to the
8 lowest responsible bidder following public solicitation of
9 bids. Any contract executed in violation of the provisions
10 of this Section, or any rules issued in connection therewith,
11 shall be null and void. The Director of Public Works is
12 authorized to issue rules, pursuant to the provisions of the
13 Administrative Adjudication Act, to establish the forms for
14 bid, the minimum publication period which shall not be less
15 than seven days, the methods of publication of the solicitation
16 for bids, bid opening methods, the criteria for awarding bids,
17 and such other matters as are required for the implementation
18 hereof."

19 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
