AN ACT TO AMEND § 5204(d) OF CHAPTER 5, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF SPORTS EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES FOR YOUTH AND COMMUNITY SPORTS PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: Annual Contract

Section 1. § 5204(d) of Chapter 5, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, is 2

- hereby amended, to read: 3
- Limited Gaming Fund. 4 ″§ 5204.
- There is hereby created, separate and apart from other funds of 5 (a) the government of Guam, a fund to be known as the Limited 6 Gaming Fund. All license fees, taxes and penalties collected 7 8 under this Act shall be deposited in the Fund. The Fund shall 9 *not* be commingled with the General Fund, except as indicated herein, shall be kept in a separate bank account, and shall not be 10

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1 used as a pledge of security or as collateral for government loans. The Director of Administration shall make an itemized 2 quarterly report to I Maga'lahen Guåhan (the Governor of 3 4 Guam), and I Liheslaturan Guåhan, of the condition of, and a detailed description of all financial activity within, the Fund. 5 6 The Director of Administration *shall* further make an itemized 7 annual report, which shall be made available to the general public. 8

- 9 (b) The Fund *shall* be used for the purpose of the administration of 10 this Act, and as otherwise stated herein. *No more than* five 11 percent of the fund balance may be expended for this purpose, 12 and funds *shall not* be expended for personnel costs. Said Fund 13 *shall* be examined and reported upon by the Director of 14 Administration as required by law.
- (c) No claim for the payment of any expense incurred by the
 Department or any other agency in the administration of this
 Act, shall be made unless it is against the Fund. No other
 moneys of the government of Guam *shall* be used or obligated
 to pay the expenses of the Department.
- 20 (d) Moneys remaining in the Fund, after maintaining the stated
 21 reserves for administrative expenses of this Act, *shall* be
 22 appropriated in the following manner in each fiscal year:

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(1)up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the (include) Mayors Council of Guam for the repair and construction of 2 village recreational facilities, including community centers, and 3 for the procurement of sports equipment and supplies; 4 up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the 5 (2)6 Department of Parks and Recreation for the repair and construction of its facilities, and for the procurement of sports 7 equipment and supplies; and 8 up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the 9 (3)Department of Education for the repair and construction of its 10sports facilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment 11 12 and supplies. 13 The Mayors Council of Guam, the Department of Parks and (e)recreation, and the Department of Education shall present 14 15 memoranda of request to the Department of Administration 16 detailing the use of funds to be allocated to each entity. Funds shall not be expended for personnel costs. The Department of 17 18 Administration *shall* release funds to each entity on the first 19 Monday of each fiscal quarter." Section 2. Effective Date. The provisions of this Act shall become 2021effective upon enactment.
