## **1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

3 Section 1. § 5204(d) of Article 2, Chapter 5, Title 11, Guam Code
4 Annotated, is hereby *amended*, to read:

5 "(d) Moneys remaining in the Fund, after maintaining the stated 6 reserves for administrative expenses of this Act, shall be are hereby 7 appropriated, and *shall* continue to be deemed appropriated, annually, in the 8 following manner in each fiscal year:

9 (1) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the Mayors 10 Council of Guam for the repair and construction of village 11 recreational facilities, including community centers, and for the 12 procurement of sports equipment and supplies, including, but not limited to, team sponsorships and uniforms. Funds may also be used to purchase equipment required to support community programs administered by village mayors;

(2) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the Department of Parks and Recreation for the repair and construction of its facilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment and supplies; and

(3) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to theDepartment of Education for the repair and construction of its sportsfacilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment and supplies.

(4) Not more than fifty percent (50%) of the amount authorized 11 12 in Item (1), twenty percent (20%) of the amount authorized in Item 13 (2), and twenty percent (20%) of the amount authorized in Item (3), respectively, of this Subsection for the repair and construction of 14 15 village recreational facilities and for the procurement of sports equipment and supplies shall be used for the procurement of sports 16 equipment and supplies, including but not limited to, team 17 sponsorships and uniforms. 18

(e) The Mayors Council of Guam, the Department of Parks and
Recreation, and the Department of Education shall present memoranda of
request to the Department of Administration detailing the use of funds to be
allocated to each entity. Funds shall not be expended for personnel costs.
The Department of Administration shall release funds to each entity on the
first Monday of each fiscal quarter."
