AN ACT TO AMEND § 5204(d) OF ARTICLE 2,  
CHAPTER 5, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,  
RELATIVE TO SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT  
OF SAFE AND HEALTHY YOUTH AND COMMUNITY  
ACTIVITIES THROUGH A DEDICATED FUNDING  
SOURCE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

3 Section 1. § 5204(d) of Article 2, Chapter 5, Title 11, Guam Code  
4 Annotated, is hereby *amended*, to read:

5 “(d) Moneys remaining in the Fund, after maintaining the stated  
6 reserves for administrative expenses of this Act, ~~shall be~~ are hereby  
7 appropriated, and shall continue to be deemed appropriated, annually, in the  
8 following manner in each fiscal year:

9 (1) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the Mayors  
10 Council of Guam for the repair and construction of village  
11 recreational facilities, including community centers, and for the  
12 procurement of sports equipment and supplies, including, but not

1 limited to, team sponsorships and uniforms. Funds may also be used  
2 to purchase equipment required to support community programs  
3 administered by village mayors;

4 (2) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the  
5 Department of Parks and Recreation for the repair and construction of  
6 its facilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment and  
7 supplies; and

8 (3) up to one third (1/3) of the available balance to the  
9 Department of Education for the repair and construction of its sports  
10 facilities, and for the procurement of sports equipment and supplies.

11 (4) Not more than fifty percent (50%) of the amount authorized  
12 in Item (1), twenty percent (20%) of the amount authorized in Item  
13 (2), and twenty percent (20%) of the amount authorized in Item (3),  
14 respectively, of this Subsection for the repair and construction of  
15 village recreational facilities and for the procurement of sports  
16 equipment and supplies shall be used for the procurement of sports  
17 equipment and supplies, including but not limited to, team  
18 sponsorships and uniforms.

19 (e) The Mayors Council of Guam, the Department of Parks and  
20 Recreation, and the Department of Education shall present memoranda of  
21 request to the Department of Administration detailing the use of funds to be  
22 allocated to each entity. Funds shall not be expended for personnel costs.  
23 The Department of Administration shall release funds to each entity on the  
24 first Monday of each fiscal quarter."

26 **Section 2. FY 2015 Appropriation.** Funds collected and available in  
27 Fiscal Year 2015 in accordance with § 5204(d) of Article 2, Chapter 5, Title 11,

1 Guam Code Annotated, are hereby appropriated from the Limited Gaming Fund as  
2 enacted by P.L. 32-060 to the Mayors Council of Guam, the Department of  
3 Education, and the Department of Parks and Recreation as set forth in § 5204(d).  
4 The Department of Administration shall release said appropriated funds to each  
5 entity as identified herein.
