AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX (HOT) SURPLUS FUND TO THE GUAM VISITOR'S BUREAU.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that there exists Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,500,000) in the Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund available for appropriation.

Section 2. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) is hereby appropriated from the Fiscal Year 2014 Hotel Occupancy Tax Surplus Fund to the Guam Visitor's Bureau for the improvement, refurbishment, restoration, repair and/or maintenance of one park or attraction per village including village murals. Notwithstanding the general provisions of § 30107.1, of Chapter 30, Title 11 GCA, this appropriation *shall* continue to be available until expended and is *not* subject to transfer or use for any other purpose.
