AN ACT TO AMEND § 8114.1 OF CHAPTER 8, TITLE 7, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYEES TO JOIN THE VOLUNTEER DEPUTY MARSHAL RESERVE PROGRAM.

ANCH S & S

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Intent. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to remove the prohibition on full-time government of Guam employees from joining the volunteer deputy marshal reserve program so that government of Guam employees may be considered for selection.
- Section 2. Enhancement of the Volunteer Deputy Marshal Reserve
 Program. § 8114.1 of Chapter 8, Title 7, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
 amended to read:
 - "§ 8114.1. Eligibility and Recruitment. A volunteer must be qualified as a Superior Court of Guam Deputy Marshal, and have graduated from either the Guam Police Academy, the Basic Law Enforcement Academy or a qualified law enforcement academic program within Guam.
- Volunteers shall be recruited from within this qualified category of eligible candidates. No full-time employee of the government of Gunm-shall be eligible for the Program."
