AN ACT TO ADD A NEW ARTICLE 4, §§ 9401-9404, TO CHAPTER 9, DIVISION 1, TITLE 12, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO PROMOTING THE GUAM PRODUCT ABROAD THROUGH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CULTURAL AND SPORTS AMBASSADORSHIP PROGRAM FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. A new Article 4, §§ 9401-9404, is hereby added to Chapter 9,
- 3 Division 1, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

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§ 9401. Legislative Statement. Cultural performers and athletes on Guam serve as integral components of Guam's tourism industry. Opportunities for cultural groups and sports teams to promote Guam's rich and unique culture

abroad help to educate other communities about, and raise awareness of, our island as a safe, clean, and pleasant destination of choice. Cultural groups and sports teams continue to strengthen Guam's image abroad through their participation in regional and international fairs, competitions, and activities.

It is, therefore, a policy of the government of Guam to identify and sustain a viable funding source to support opportunities for cultural organizations and sports teams to assist in the enhancement of the Guam product abroad through their participation in activities that are duly approved by the Guam Visitors Bureau.

§ 9402. Cultural and Sports Ambassadorship Program Fund, established. There is hereby created, separate and apart from all other funds, the Guam Visitors Bureau "Cultural and Sports Ambassadorship Program Fund" (hereinafter referred to as Fund). The deposits into the Fund shall not be commingled with deposits received from the Tourist Attraction Fund for the operations, special projects, and any other appropriations made to the Guam Visitors Bureau, and shall be kept in a separate bank account. The bank account shall be established and maintained by the Guam Visitors Bureau, and its funds shall only be available for use as stipulated herein.

§ 9403. Annual Deposit. No less than Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) of the adopted revenue projection of the Tourist Attraction Fund for each fiscal year shall be set aside and allocated by the Department of Administration to the Guam Visitors Bureau for deposit into the Fund established by this Section. Each annual deposit shall be made over the course of the fiscal year as collections are received. Financial contributions may also be made to the Fund by participating businesses and organizations, as sponsors of cultural groups and sports teams.

Any unexpended balance of the Cultural and Sports Ambassadorship Program Fund *shall not* revert to the Tourist Attraction Fund or any other fund, and *shall* be available until fully expended for the purposes described herein.

§ 9404. Adoption of Rules. The Guam Visitors Bureau *shall* adopt, through a resolution approved by the Board of Directors of the Guam Visitors Bureau, the rules necessary to effectuate the provisions herein which shall include, but not be limited to, the definition of a Sports Ambassador, the types of fairs, competitions, and activities to be authorized, the amounts to be awarded to cultural groups and sports teams, the eligibility criteria for selection, and the requirements for organizations to complete community service hours as a condition for receiving public funds. The rules and regulations *shall* ensure that Fund proceeds are used exclusively to support cultural groups sanctioned by the Guam Visitors Bureau, youth sport teams participating in nationally and internationally recognized competitions, and other sports teams that are members of sports federations duly endorsed by the Guam National Olympic Committee."

Section 2. Initial Deposit. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Director of Administration is hereby authorized to deposit up to Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) from the unappropriated balance of the Tourist Attraction Fund for Fiscal Year 2014 into the Cultural and Sports Ambassadorship Program Fund for use during Fiscal Year 2015. Of this amount, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) shall be allocated to support youth sports teams participating in nationally and internationally recognized competitions during Fiscal Year 2015, and One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) shall be allocated to support Sports Ambassadors competing in the 2015 Pacific Games.

Section 3. Effective Date. The provisions of this Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.
