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AN ACT TO AMEND §2101.1(f) AND §2101.3 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 5 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING THE INDEPENDENCE OF THE JUDICIARY OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE RECEIPT OF FEDERAL FUNDS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan hereby extends the recognition of judicial independence to the application, receipt and administration of federal funds.

**Section 2.** Item (f) of §2101.1 of Chapter 2 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read:

7 "(f) With the exception of the Judiciary of Guam, the Guam 8 Community College, the University of Guam, and the Guam 9 Department of Education, and notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, no application for any Federal 10 11 aid programs, grants, loans, contracts, contributions, advances, 12 direct Federal development, or other Federal funding shall be submitted or deemed approved on behalf of the government of 13 14 Guam or any agency, division, office, department or
