# AN ACT TO AMEND § 23111(b) AND § 23111(e)(3) OF CHAPTER 23, DIVISION 2, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE USE OF GOVERNMENT TRAVEL MILEAGE BENEFITS FOR OFF-ISLAND STUDENT TRAVEL INVOLVING ACADEMIC, SPORTS, AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES.

### **1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. § 23111(b) and § 23111(e)(3) of Chapter 23, Division 2, Title 5,
Guam Code Annotated, are hereby *amended*, to read:

4 "(b) Medical Referral and Education Mileage Program. There is hereby created within the government of Guam an accrued travel mileage 5 6 program for the use of travel mileage earned as a result of travel paid by the government of Guam through the use of government of Guam credit cards 7 8 purchases. This program shall be known as the Senator Edward J. Cruz 9 Medical Referral and Education Mileage Program (MREMP) to be 10administered by the Department of Administration for all travel conducted 11 by employees of the Executive Branch of the government of Guam. The Guam Legislature, the Unified Judiciary of Guam, and other agencies, 12 instrumentalities, autonomous agencies, and public corporations of the 13 government of Guam that purchase airline tickets through the use of credit 14

- cards, shall adm.inister their respective accrued travel mileage programs
   pursuant to the requirements of this Section."

"(e) Eligibility.

4 (3) A <u>GDOE</u> student who is authorized by <u>a committee</u>
5 <u>established by</u> the Superintendent of Education to participate at an off6 island academic, sports or cultural activity is also eligible for
7 participation to receive the mileage benefits."

8 Section 2. Effective Date. The provisions of this Act *shall* become 9 effective upon enactment.
