7 Section 2. Appropriation. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the

sum of Four Million Four Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-

Nine Dollars (\$4,494,969) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated,

unallocated fund balance of the FY 2014 Tourist Attraction Fund for the following:

(a) Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) to fund various activities of the

2016 Festivals of the Pacific Arts; and

(b) Two Million Four Hundred Ninety Four Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Nine Dollars (\$2,494,969) to fund payments due to Government of Guam employees resulting from the enactment of the Competitive Wage Act and the unpaid balance of base pay adjustments due to Law Enforcement Officers pursuant to \$55102 of Chapter 55, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated.

Section 3. Severability. If a provision f this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this act that can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are severable.
