Veto of Bill No. 207-30(LS), to adopt the procedures manual for the acquisition, enforcement and maintenance of territorial highway right-of-way and standards; to require legislative approval of revisions to the Guam Transportation Improvement Plan; to *amend* §17109 of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to relocation assistance; and to establish the Highway Commission.
7. Veto of Bill No. 233-30(COR), relative to the Rules and Regulations for the School Property of the Department of Education.
8. Veto of Bill No. 270-30(LS) relative to requiring volunteers to display their identification card and to be in prescribed uniform attire while issuing citation for the purpose of immediate recognition of authority.
